**Object: Participation to the She Runs project**

*To all School Sport Entities part of the Erasmus + Program Countries*

Dear European school sport friends,

Following the launch of **She Runs**, the first and largest school sport event dedicated to young women and organised by the ISF, I am proud to announce that the ISF has been awarded a grant by the **Erasmus+ Program of the European Union** to foster the participation of the European countries.

Therefore, the ISF invites every delegation of at least 10 people (8 girls and 2 adults) and a maximum of 15 people (12 girls and 3 adults), coming from School Sport Entities in countries that are listed as Erasmus+ Program countries in 2019<sup>1</sup>. Their **participation will be free of cost**; this includes transportation to Paris (flight or bus to be confirmed), local transportation, accommodation, food, activities. Delegation will still have to pay a **symbolic registration fee** per person (see in Bulletin 1).

Moreover, the program also dedicates a **specific educational section for a group of 50 selected girls in Paris, from March 14<sup>th</sup> (afternoon) to 15<sup>th</sup>, 2019** (departure from Paris on the 16<sup>th</sup>). In each delegation, two girls with an adult can apply to be selected; all costs related to this experience will also be covered by the ISF. This training takes place in addition of the general program (race, sport village, conference, and cultural day) from March 12<sup>th</sup> to 14<sup>th</sup>. Please refer to the Annexe to see the full program.

Stay tuned on the ISF website to get to know the registration details (Bulletin, ERAS and consent forms) and the selection process, which will be published soon.

We look forward to seeing your most active young sportswomen in Paris representing the new leaders of school sport.
